**WHAT IS EARLY SUPPORT?** Early Support Wales is the Welsh Assembly Government mechanism to improve services for disabled children and children with additional needs and their families. Early Support has developed a range of resources and training that is aimed at bringing service providers together to work in partnership with families to ensure the child and family's requirements are met. **The aim is to put parents at the centre of the planning process.**

**Early Support aims to improve the lives of children with additional needs and their families. It is specifically aimed at children aged 5 years or under.**

Contact a Family will now be working on engaging parents in Early Support. Over the next year we will aim to make sure that as many parents of disabled children as possible know about Early Support. Regular bulletins will keep parents up to date with what is happening locally, how to make best use of the ES materials and website and what other parents are doing across Wales. We will also be getting out and about visiting as many parent groups as possible.

**HOW DO I GET INVOLVED?** If you are the parent of a young child and early on in the voyage of discovery, you can access information and helpful free materials from the website.

The website will also keep you up to date on free local courses for parents and working with professionals in the area of disability. The first round of the Parent Workshops have just taken place and were a great success, watch out for more dates near you later in the year.

## PARENT WORKSHOPS

Early Support Workshops are co-run by parents of children with additional needs who have undertaken the parent trainer course.

In the last Contact a Family newsletter we announced the dates for the first round of four Parent Workshops and 50 parents attended at five different venues. Interested parents are now coming forward to become parent trainers themselves: spreading the word across Wales – by the experts, the parents! The workshops offer:

- help to find out what support is available for you and your family and meet other parents in a similar situation
- help to feel better informed so that you are ready to have more of a say in planning services for your child
- Sharing of ideas about enjoying life with your whole family, no matter how challenging that might feel at times

## OTHER EARLY SUPPORT TRAINING

### Working in Partnership (WIP)

A range of courses aimed at practitioners, parents and carers. These do not lead to a qualification but provide important information and the opportunity to develop skills.

### Accredited courses

Early Support courses aimed at practitioners, managers, parents and carers which lead to a Level 4 award and one that leads to an accredited University module.

**Key Worker Training** (The worker that takes a lead role and works holistically).

The Early Support key worker training aims to ensure that as many individuals as possible understand the function of a key worker and can take that role.

## EARLY SUPPORT MATERIALS

### The Family File and Background Information

The Family File is a family-held document, which brings together all relevant information about a child’s needs and services supporting the family and has proved extremely popular with parents attending the Parent Workshops. It is designed to be portable as you attend appointments and meetings where your child’s situation and development are being discussed. It can also help you tell health practitioners, childminders or staff working in playgroups and Early Years settings, about your child. It includes a range of background information booklets which parents themselves say is useful to know. Some people like to use the booklets separately and some use them alongside the Early Support Family file.

### NEW! Developmental Journal

There are four different journals, designed for you to track your child’s progress in your own words under helpful headings. Very useful, if you are concerned about your child or if you know or suspect your child is not developing at same rate or way as other children. As well as the main version there are specific journals for deaf babies and children, Downs Syndrome and babies and children with a visual impairment.
